Covid-19: The meet will be organised in-line with the most recent coronavirus guidelines as of

April 2022, as announced by the UK government and Swim England, in collaboration with JCCS and local Health and Safety authorities. We will regularly update guidance in the 2 weeks leading up to the meet and ask all participating clubs and individual

entrants to follow these communications.

Venue: The meet is to be held at The Aquatics Centre, John Charles Centre for Sport. The pool

will be 25 metres, 10 lanes, anti-wave ropes, and a separate swim down facility is

available subject to proper use. Electronic timing will be used.

Ages: Age as at 3rd April 2022.

Age Groups: Boys and Girls: 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and over.

Events 100m all Strokes

100 IM

Entries: Entries will only be accepted online at www.openmeets.co.uk/entry_sys. Entries

should be submitted by the entry closing date, Friday 4th March 2022. Entries accepted on a **FIRST COME FIRST SERVED** basis according to ASA guidelines only, until event and session times are full based on OpenMeets software processing. Entry forms submitted by individuals/families will incur a £1 non-refundable administration fee. Poolside entries on the day will be strictly at the promotor's discretion and will only be accepted

from competitors already at the meet.

Rejections: Any rejections will be communicated to the clubs by email from the on-line entry

system.

Fees: £6.00 per event. Coaches pass £15 for the day to include lunch, refreshments and start

sheets. Please apply and pay with entries. Payment by BACS is preferred: Account Name - York City Baths Club; Sort Code - 05-05-27; Account Number - 41635200. Cheques should be made payable to York City Baths Club and posted to the Promoter

(see below).

Refunds: No refunds will be given after the closing date or after entries are closed because the

meet is full, whichever is the earliest, unless medical evidence is presented for an injury, coronavirus infection or Covid-19 mandated isolation. If the meet cannot go ahead due

to government issued guidelines a full refund will be given.



Seeding: Heats will be seeded/spearheaded according to entry times. Start sheets will be

published on a dedicated live website shortly before the start of each session. The link

shared with all participants in advance. All events will be Heat Declared Winner.

Results: Full results will be available to view and download shortly after each session is complete

on a dedicated live results site. The link will be shared with all participants in advance.

Awards: Medals will be awarded for each heat declared winner event to the first three in each

age group. The collection of medals and awards will be arranged in-line with current

coronavirus guidelines.

Referee: The referee's decision is final.

Starts: Over the top starts may be used at the discretion of the meet promoter. A starting

strobe will be available to assist deaf swimmers.

Finishes: Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool.

Withdrawals: Withdrawals must be given to the recorder at the start of each session warm up

relevant to the event entered.

Poolside: York City Baths Club will not be responsible for any unaccompanied swimmers on

Poolside. The responsibility falls on the club entering the swimmer, who should appoint

an individual to be on poolside, i.e. a DBS checked adult with a coach's pass.

Drinks on poolside must be in plastic drinks bottles only.

No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside.

Swimmers are respectfully reminded to remain in their allocated seating areas, and

must not gain admittance to the spectator area.

Spectators: Spectators will be admitted subject to coronavirus guidance at the time; Admission for

spectators will be £7 + administration fee for the day. Children under 9, accompanied by an adult, will be admitted free only if the venue has no Covid related capacity

restrictions in place.

Photography: The use of video or photographic equipment within the pool area shall be in compliance

with the relevant ASA policy in effect at the time of the meet.

Swim Shop: A swim shop may be in operation throughout the meet.

General: There is a café at the venue, subject to current Covid-19 rules.

A professional photographer may be operating throughout the gala.

Any point not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the meet promoter and

lead referee.

Closing date: Friday 4th March 2022 (or whenever the meet is full)
