The Welfare Officer will have a right to attend Committee meetings without a power to vote. Attendance at meetings will be for the purpose of sharing or addressing matters relating to Welfare.

In the event the Welfare Officer is related to or in a relationship with any one of the Committee or the Club's Coaches or Teachers (Person A), the Welfare Officer shall refer any Wavepower-related matter concerning Person A to the Chair for independent Welfare management.
