York City Baths Club currently has a vacancy for a Lead Coach (Development Squad).

Ideally, candidates will hold Level 2 coaching qualifications (or be working towards them); a NRASTAC or NPLQ lifeguarding qualification is essential. We are looking to appoint a highly motivated individual, possessing excellent communication skills and an understanding of the ASA Long Term Athlete Development model. The role necessitates working unsociable hours, and committing to attendance at galas to support the Club's competitive programme of events.

The Executive Committee is looking to appoint a paid Service Provider to fulfil this role. Remuneration will be subject to experience and qualifications. Under the direction of the Head Coach, it is essential that the successful candidate demonstrates a willingness to collaborate with the Club's coaching and teaching community, to help the Club fulfil all its aims and objectives.

The club currently has 200 swimmers in its competitive squads, with a further 300 swimmers in its Learn To Swim scheme. It operates from six venues across the city and is regularly represented at all levels of competition from Graded Meets to National Championships.

The Development Squad is the next step for those who have completed their journey through learn to swim. The aim is to develop technique across all four strokes and to teach them the skills required for the training environment. The Squad currently meets four times a week.
