Covid-19: The meet will be organised in-line with the most recent coronavirus guidelines as of

March 2023, as announced by the UK government and Swim England, in collaboration

with JCCS and local Health and Safety authorities.

Venue: The meet is to be held at The Aquatics Centre, John Charles Centre for Sport. The pool

will be 50 metres, 10 lanes, anti-wave ropes, and a separate swim down facility is

available subject to proper use. Electronic timing will be used.

Ages: Age as at 31th December 2023.

Age Groups: Boys and Girls: 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 and over.

Entries: Entries will only be accepted online at www.openmeets.co.uk/entry sys before the

entry closing date, Friday 24th February 2023. Entries have to be faster or equal than the qualifying times published for the meet. After the closing date, if the meet is over capacity, each entry time will be lowered by the same proportion and the slowest entries rejected until the numbers reach the allowed capacity. There will be 30 swimmers allowed for the 800 freestyle, and 20 swimmers for the 1500 freestyle with the slowest entries rejected as described above. Entry forms submitted by individuals/families will incur a £1 non-refundable administration fee. No poolside

entries.

Rejections: Any rejections will be communicated to the clubs by email from the on-line entry

system.

Fees: £8.50 per event with exception of the 800m and 1500m freestyle, for which the charge

will be £12 per event. Coaches pass £30 for the weekend to include start sheets, lunch

and refreshments. Please pay only once rejections are communicated. Payment by BACS is preferred: Account Name - York City Baths Club; Sort Code - 05-05-27; Account Number - 41635200. Cheques should be made payable to York City Baths Club and posted to the Promoter (see below).

Refunds: No refunds will be given, unless medical evidence is presented for an injury, coronavirus

infection or Covid-19 mandated isolation. If the meet cannot go ahead due to

government issued guidelines a full refund will be given.

Seeding: Heats will be seeded/spearheaded according to entry times. All events will be Heat

Declared Winner.

Results: Full results will be available to view and download shortly after each session is

complete.

Awards: Medals will be awarded for each heat declared winner event to the first three in each

age group. The collection of medals and awards will be arranged in-line with current

coronavirus guidelines.

Referee: The referee's decision is final.

Starts: Over the top starts may be used at the discretion of the meet promoter. A starting

strobe will be available to assist hearing impaired swimmers.

Finishes: Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool.

Withdrawals: Withdrawals must be given to the recorder at the start of each session warm up

relevant to the event entered.

Poolside: York City Baths Club will not be responsible for any unaccompanied swimmers on

Poolside. The responsibility falls on the club entering the swimmer, who should appoint

an individual to be on poolside, i.e. a DBS checked adult with a coach's pass.

Drinks on poolside must be in plastic drinks bottles only.

No outdoor shoes to be worn on the poolside.

Swimmers are respectfully reminded to remain on poolside and must not gain

admittance to the spectator area.

Spectators: Spectators will be admitted subject to coronavirus guidance at the time and payment

of an admission fee at the door (under 10s free of charge).

Photography: The use of video or photographic equipment within the pool area shall be in compliance

with the relevant ASA policy in effect at the time of the meet.

Swim Shop: A swim shop may be in operation throughout the meet.

General: There is a café at the venue, subject to current Covid-19 rules.

A professional photographer may be operating throughout the gala.

Any point not covered in the above will be at the discretion of the meet promoter and

lead referee.
